# What's happening this month

Update Hurricane Beryl:

CCWSC lost power in the plant and went on generator on Monday, July 8, 2024 at 2:30am. The plant never shut down and continued water service throughout the storm. CCWSC Maintenance staff had prepared for the storm prior filling the Ground Water Storage Tank to the maximum and making sure everything was running properly. Once the storm hit everything went as planned with no issues. The only damage was to the fence and main water office roof. The fence has been fixed by maintenance and the roof is inprocess of being repaired.

Thank you to Maintenance department for monitoring the plant before, during and after the storm to keep our water plant operational.

We heard through TRWA who assist with water departments during emergencies that many WCS were struggling to keep their pressure above 20 psi. We were very fortunate with all the repairs, equipment replacement and upgrades that we were very prepared for this storm.

This is why the assessment was necessary to ensure that our plant could handle the stress of a storm of this magnitude. We will continue to make improvements to our infrastructure to ensure the future success of our corporation.
